

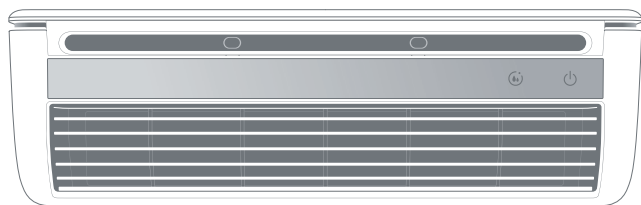

1. Please read the user manual carefully before use and use it correctly according to the instructions;
2. If the power cord is damaged, in order to avoid danger, it must be replaced by professionals;
3. Sharp objects such as metals and needles are prohibited from falling into this product to prevent short circuits;
4. Do not use corrosive cleaning agents or diluents to clean products;
5. Please do not let pets such as cats and dogs play or bite on this product to prevent pets from damaging the power supply and wiring;
6. Do not pull or entangle the internal power cord of the product;
7. Individuals who are unable to take care of themselves, infants and young children, or those who are not sensitive to heat must be accompanied by a guardian for use;
8. When not in use, please turn off the power promptly and unplug the power plug;
9. When the product is hung on a wall hanging buckle, the buckle should be perpendicular to the ground (cannot be tilted left or right) and smoothly pasted on a smooth wall surface for 24 hours before the entire machine can be hung on the wall;
10. When using hooks for products, the place where the hooks are hung should be stable and firm to prevent them from falling off;
11. Do not use wet hands to unplug the power plug to avoid the risk of electric shock;
12. When there are stains on the surface of the product, you can use a soft cloth dipped in soap to wipe it clean. Do not use organic solvents such as gasoline or alcohol to scrub;
13. Do not use in areas with high temperature, humidity, high dust, or volatile acidic or alkaline oils;

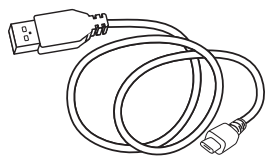
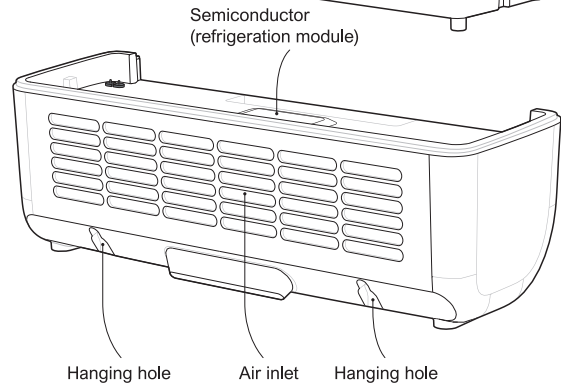
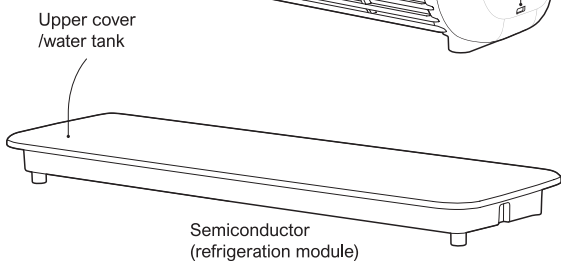
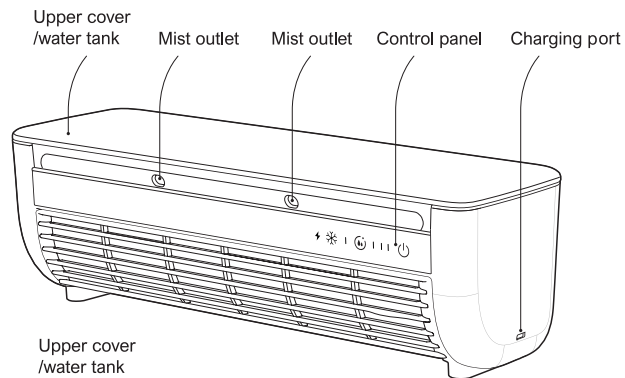

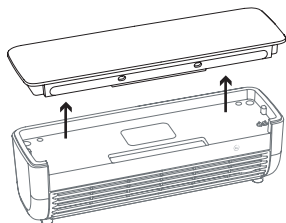
Front view

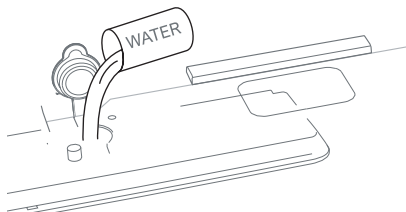

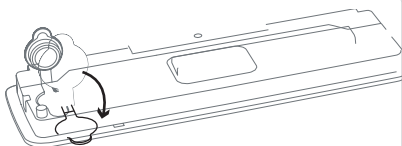
OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS



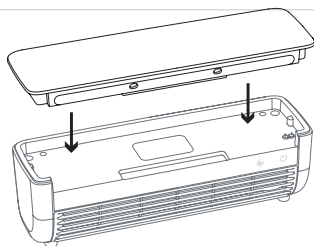
Gently lift the lid (water tank) on the product and discard the protective cotton underneath the lid.



Turn the lid (water tank) upside down, lift the silicone sealing lid, and add clean water to the hole.



After adding water, tighten the silicone sealing cap again.

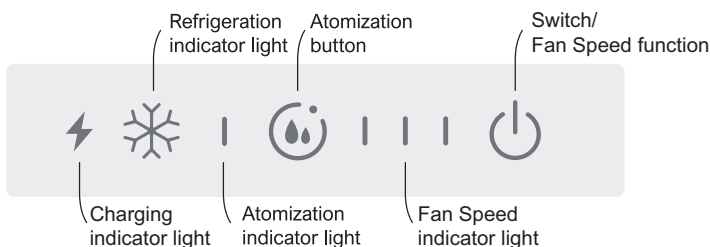


Simply reinstall the cover (water tank) onto the product

NOTE: Residual water may be found in the water tank. This is left from leak proof testing before leaving the factory.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

CONTROL PANEL



⏻ Switch/Fan Speed function

In standby mode, press and hold the ⏻ button for 2 seconds to turn on the device. The product enters low fan speed, and the corresponding gear indicator light will light up. Afterwards, with each short press of the ⏻ key, the wind speed will increase by one, starting from LOW, MED., HIGH, - shutdown. Press and hold the ⏻ button for 2 seconds in any Speed to turn off the device

💧 Atomization function

When turned on, press the 💧 button once, the ultrasonic atomizer and semiconductor refrigeration unit will start working, and the atomization indicator light will turn on, the light ❄️ is in a breathing state.

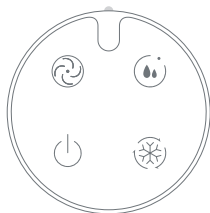
Press the 💧 button again, and the atomizer and semiconductor cooling chip will stop working, and the corresponding indicator light will turn off.

When it is detected that the atomizer has no working current (the water tank is removed or not installed in place), the semiconductor refrigeration chip will take 3 minutes to stop working and will restart after 3 minutes when water tank is replaced.

The working principle of semiconductor refrigeration chips: turn on for 5 minutes, turn off for 10 minutes, turn on for 5 minutes, and cycle like this;

The atomizing and cooling blades only work when turned on, and stop working when the fan is turned off.

Remote control panel



- ⏻ Turn on/off the fan.
- ⌚ In working mode, press the ⌚ button to switch the fan speed, and the product will cycle through LOW, MED., HIGH fan speed.
- 💧 In the working state, press the 💧 key to turn on/off the spray and refrigeration functions.
- ❄️ In working mode, press the ❄️ button activate the REFRIGERATION function. The fan speed will turn to HIGH for max cooling efficiency; The spray and refrigeration functions are turned on at the same time. In REFRIGERATION mode, press the ❄️ button to exit Refrigeration mode. The fan speed will turn to LOW and the spray and refrigeration functions will turn OFF at the same time.

BATTERY & CHARGING INFORMATION

When the battery level remains at 30%, ⚡ the light will flash at a low frequency (with an interval of 2 seconds), indicating that the battery level is low. The wind speed can only work in LOW or MED. Speed and cannot be placed on HIGH. The cooling plate will stop working.

When the battery level is less than 10%, ⚡ the light will flash at high frequency (with an interval of 0.5 seconds), and the buzzer will sound two beeps to indicate charging is needed. The fan speed will only work in LOW and cannot be placed on a higher setting. When the battery level is zero, all functions are turned off and all lights are turned off.

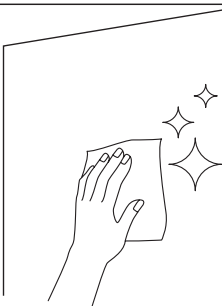
When charging, the light is in a breathing state. After being fully charged, ⚡ the light remains on; Fully charge and unplug the adapter, the light goes out.

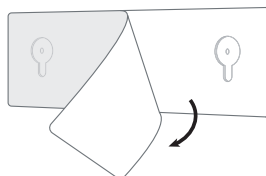

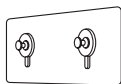
INSTALLATION



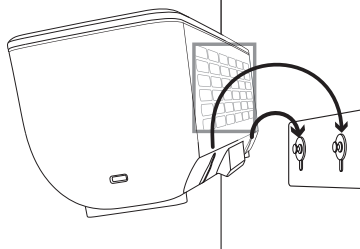
Wipe the wall with a towel to keep it clean and dry



Tear off the protective film on the back of the strong adhesive hook



Attach the adhesive hook to the wall, press firmly to release air, and let it stand for at least 24 hours.



Align the hanging hole on the back of the product with the hook and hang it properly



- Strong adhesive hooks are recommended for indoor areas with smooth walls. Please do not install them outdoors in areas with dust, crevices and other non smooth surfaces;
- Wall surfaces suitable for adhesive hooks: smooth tiles, smooth glass, painted panels, smooth metals, etc;
- Adhesive hooks are not suitable for walls: wall paper, putty walls, cement walls, wooden board walls, mud walls,unsmooth, non hard walls,etc.

CLEANING AND CARE

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

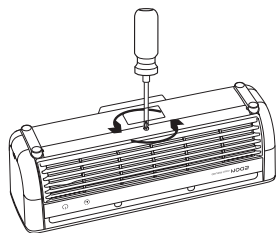
- Cut off the power supply before maintenance
- When there is oil stains on the body, it must be cleaned thoroughly to avoid discoloration and damage.
- After maintenance and cleaning, pack each component into a packaging box in the original packaging order and place it in a dry place for proper storage.
- This machine only requires general external cleaning and maintenance.
- Do not rinse the body directly with water.
- Avoid wiping with diluents, toluene, acidic detergents, oil, etc. to prevent discoloration or deterioration.

The front grill is removable and washable

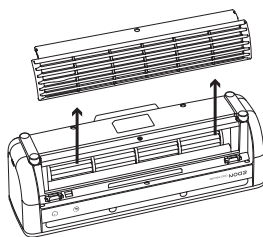
When there is a lot of dust accumulation on the current mesh cover, it can be disassembled and washed in the shutdown state. After the front mesh cover is fully dried, it can be installed and the product can be reopened.

! CAUTION! Before removing the front grill, it is necessary to confirm that the fan and power supply are disconnected; Do not disassemble the front grill while the fan is in operation:

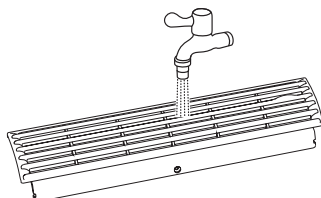
Do not turn on the machine if the front grill is not installed properly or the fan blades are exposed.



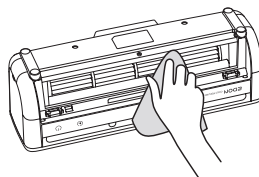
At the bottom of the product body, remove the screws that secure the front grill cover.



Lift the front grill with both hands and pull it out along the card slot to remove it.



The front grill can be individually rinsed with water.



The body and internal wind turbine cannot be rinsed with water. Please gently wipe with a clean towel.

Plug the small end of the USB-C Cable into the port located on the back of the unit. Make sure the other end of the USB cable is securely connected to a computer or other working USB power source.

DISPOSING THE UNIT

This product contains recyclable materials. Recycling and disposal should refer to local laws and regulations.

Before disposing of equipment, the battery must be removed from the equipment; When removing the battery, the appliance must be powered off; The battery should be safely disposed of.

① Gently lift the cover (water tank) on the product ② Use a screwdriver to remove the two screws on the machine casing and the air outlet network component. Remove the bottom screw ③ from the air mesh component, and then remove the three screws ④. After removing the upper shell, you can see the battery. Remove the red terminal on the battery cable to remove the battery.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Troubleshoot your problem by using the chart below. If the unit still does not work properly, W Appliance Co. contact customer service center or the nearest authorized service center. Customer must never troubleshoot internal components.
